SUMMARY OF FISHERIES STATISTICS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA - 1952

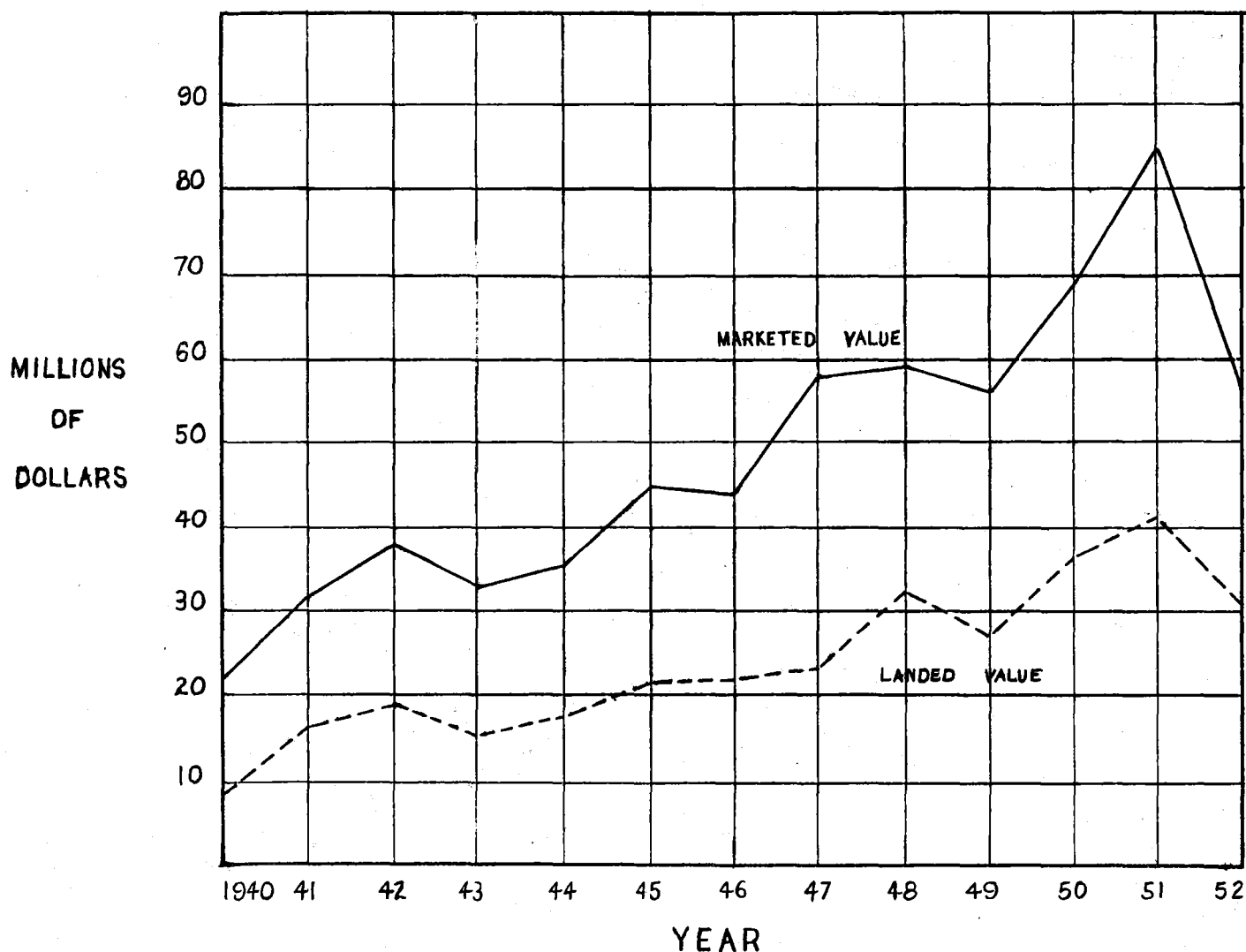
FISH AND FISH PRODUCTS

TOTAL

THE TOTAL MARKETED VALUE OF ALL FISH AND FISH PRODUCTS IN 1952 AS REPORTED BY BRITISH COLUMBIA FISHING COMPANIES WAS \$56,635,000, REPRESENTING A DECLINE OF 32% FROM THE RECORD PEAK OF 83.8 MILLION DOLLARS IN 1951. THE LANDED VALUE OF ALL FISH AND MAMMALS INCLUDING WHALES, HAIR SEALS AND FISH LIVERS ALSO DROPPED FROM \$40,638,000 IN 1951 TO \$30,158,000 IN 1952.

THESE DECLINES CAN BE ATTRIBUTED TO THREE FACTORS. FIRST THE AVAILABILITY OF TWO IMPORTANT SPECIES OF SALMON, NAMELY COHO AND CHUMS, WAS MUCH LESS THAN DURING THE PREVIOUS YEAR, SECOND THERE WAS A SUBSTANTIAL LOSS IN VOLUME OF CATCH DUE TO STRIKE ACTION IN BOTH THE SALMON AND HERRING FISHERY DURING THE PERIOD WHEN THE UNION AND OPERATORS FAILED TO AGREE ON A PRICE SETTLEMENT AND LASTLY THE LANDED AND MARKETED PRICE FOR THE MAIN SPECIES OF FISH WAS LOWER IN 1952 THAN IT WAS THE PREVIOUS YEAR.

SALMON

SALMON, THE MOST IMPORTANT SPECIES OF FISH IN BRITISH COLUMBIA ACCOUNTED FOR 40.5 MILLION DOLLARS OR 71% OF THE TOTAL MARKETED VALUE OF ALL FISH.

TOTAL LANDINGS OF THIS SPECIES IN 1952 TOTALLED 147 MILLION POUNDS (151.1 MILLION POUNDS ROUND WEIGHT) OR APPROXIMATELY 50 MILLION POUNDS LESS THAN THE PREVIOUS YEAR. OF THE TOTAL SALMON LANDED, 61.5% WAS CANNED, 18% WAS SOLD FRESH, AND 19.0% WAS FROZEN. THE REMAINING 1.5% INCLUDED

MILD CURED, KIPPERED OR SMOKED PRODUCTS.

THE TOTAL PACK OF SALMON IN 1952 WAS 1,298,557 CASES WITH AN ESTIMATED MARKETED VALUE OF \$28,505,000. THIS REPRESENTS THE LOWEST PACK DURING THE PAST 5 YEARS.

HERRING

THE QUANTITY OF HERRING LANDED IN 1952 WAS APPROXIMATELY ONE HALF OF THE TOTAL USUALLY REPORTED. THIS WAS DUE TO THE ALMOST COMPLETE TIE UP OF THE SEINE FLEET DURING THE FALL OF 1952.

THIS LOWER QUANTITY OF HERRING TO-GETHER WITH A MARKED DECLINE IN THE HERRING OIL MARKET, REDUCED THE TOTAL MARKET VALUE OF HERRING IN 1952 TO \$4,235,000 AS COMPARED WITH \$10,670,000 IN 1951.

HALIBUT

IN 1952, HALIBUT WAS THE SECOND MOST IMPORTANT SPECIES MARKETED AND WAS VALUED AT \$5,672,000. LANDINGS IN 1952 WERE HIGHEST IN RECENT YEARS.

SOLES

DESPITE A PROLONGED TIE UP OF THE MAIN TRAWLING FLEET, THE TOTAL LANDINGS OF SOLE WERE 14.4 MILLION POUNDS, UP SUBSTANTIALLY OVER THE PREVIOUS YEAR.

WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 350,000 POUNDS SOLD AS WHOLE FISH, THIS WAS ENTIRELY A FILLETING OPERATION WITH TOTAL PRODUCTS OF FILLETS TO BE DISPOSED OF EITHER FRESH OR FROZEN TALLING 4,553,000 POUNDS. HOWEVER, IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT 1,579,000 POUNDS OR NEARLY ONE THIRD OF THIS PRODUCTION REMAINED IN STORAGE IN B.C. AT THE END OF 1952 AS COMPARED WITH LESS THAN 367,000 POUNDS THE SAME PERIOD OF THE PREVIOUS YEAR.

OTHER SPECIES

OTHER SPECIES OF FISH WHILE OF LESSER IMPORTANCE IN RELATION TO THOSE ALREADY MENTIONED, AT THE SAME TIME CONTRIBUTED IN CONSIDERABLE MEASURE TO THE OVERALL MARKETED TOTAL. IN ORDER OF IMPORTANCE, THE MARKETED VALUE OF THESE WERE AS FOLLOWS WITH 1951 VALUES ALSO SHOWN IN BRACKETS. LING COD \$590,000 (\$826,300), GRAY COD \$521,000 (\$454,000), CLAMS \$477,000 (\$382,000), CRABS \$475,000 (\$403,000), OYSTERS \$438,000 (\$290,000), BLACK COD \$310,000 (\$501,000).

BOATS

IN 1952 THERE ^{were} ~~was~~ 8570 BOATS VALUED AT \$42,161,000 ENGAGED IN COMMERCIAL FISHING IN BRITISH COLUMBIA. OF THIS NUMBER 913 WERE OVER 10 TONS, WHILE 7657 WERE 10 TON OR LESS.

IN THE LARGE BOAT CLASS 738 WERE DIESEL OPERATED AS COMPARED WITH 171 GAS. A DETAILED BREAKDOWN BY TYPE OF BOAT IN THE OVER 10 TON CLASS IS SHOWN IN TABLE 6 OF THIS REPORT.

GILLNET BOATS PREDOMINATE IN THE SMALLER BOAT GROUP WITH A TOTAL OF 3828 GILLNETTERS BEING REPORTED. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE GILLNETTERS THAT ARE ALSO EQUIPPED FOR TROLLING. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TROLLERS REPORTED WAS 2732 WHICH INCLUDES THE 1349 SMALL BOATS LESS THAN 20 FEET IN LENGTH OF WHICH 233 ARE EITHER ROW BOATS OR CANOES.

GEAR

THE TOTAL VALUE OF GEAR USED IN THE B.C. FISHERY IN 1952 WAS VALUED AT \$6,570,000. THIS INCLUDED 7437 SALMON GILLNETS VALUED AT \$2,560,000, 483 SALMON PURSE SEINES TOTALLING \$1,560,000 AND 90 PURSE SEINES AVERAGING \$10,000 EACH. TROLLING LINES WERE ESTIMATED AT \$290,000 WHILE LONG LINE GEAR TOTALLED \$354,000.

FURTHER DETAILS WITH RESPECT TO MARKETED QUANTITIES BY INDIVIDUAL SPECIES AND DETAILED INFORMATION ON SALMON PACK, AS WELL AS BOAT AND GEAR VALUES ARE TO BE FOUND IN TABLES 1 - 8 IN THIS REPORT.
