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F O R E W O R D

This annual summary of British Columbia Catch Statistics follows the format originally used in 1969. It will be followed by a detailed Annual Report to be made available on written request.

Preliminary monthly printouts are prepared throughout the year which summarize landings and values by species. This Annual Summary includes revisions of these data and represents final statistics for 1977.

Prior to 1973 net caught salmon was valued at the cash buying price or minimum prices negotiated by the United Fishermen and Allied Workers Union and the Fisheries Association of British Columbia. Since 1973 actual prices paid on the fishing grounds have been used because competition for salmon has resulted in higher than minimum negotiated prices being paid.

Weights shown may be dressed or round, and are indicated on table headings. Halibut landings include fish delivered by Canadian fishermen to U.S. ports.

Monthly periods do not coincide with calendar months, but are held constant as four or five weekly periods for historical comparison. Four week periods are March, May, June, August, September and November; Five weeks: April, July and October.

This report was compiled by the staff of the Statistics Service Unit from summaries developed by the Data Processing Unit.

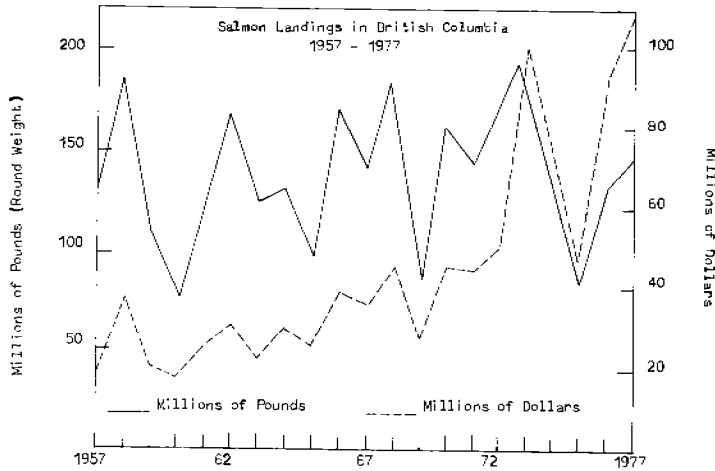

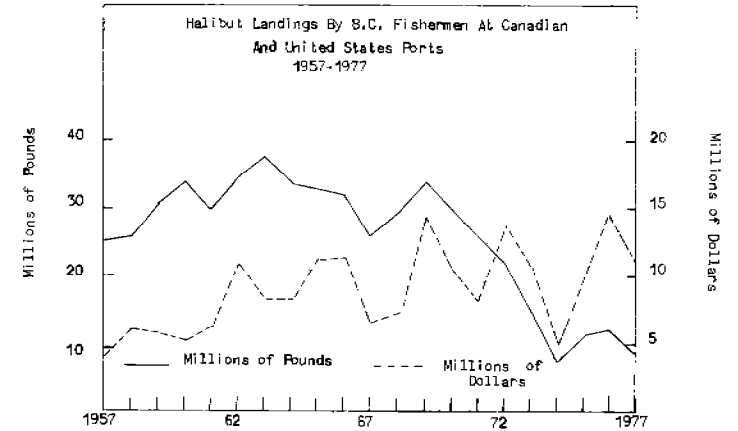
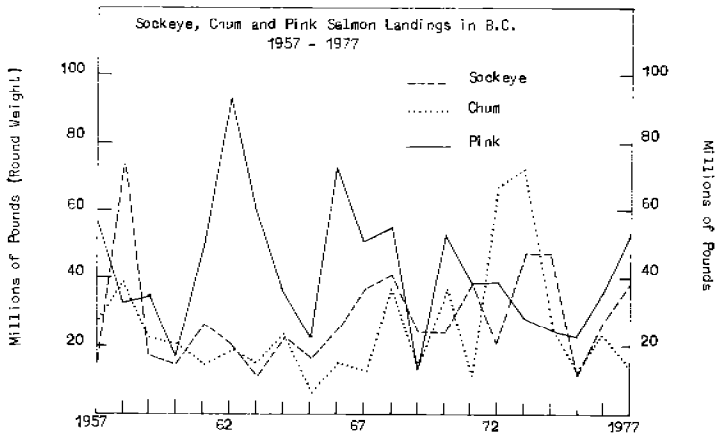
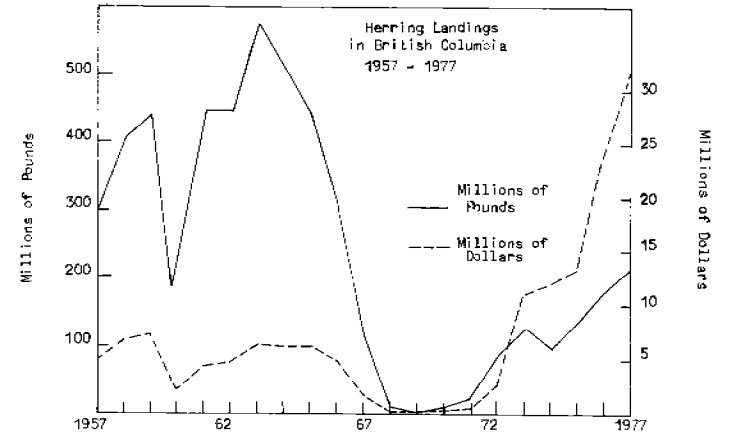


Another record year was experienced by British Columbia fishermen with the landed value of all fish and shellfish climbing to \$167.9 million - up 48 percent from the previous record year in 1976. Salmon and herring accounted for most of the increase while halibut declined in importance from 1976.

This year's salmon catch set an all time record value of \$108.7 million - up by 8.7 percent from the previous record set in 1973. From 1976 to 1977 spring and coho salmon recorded close to the same level of landings while substantial increases were shown by sockeye and pink salmon. Sockeye landings increased to 38.2 million pounds valued at \$32.2 million from their 1976 level of 27.1 million pounds valued at \$20.6 million. Pink landings of 52.3 million pounds valued at \$22.3 million were up by 40.8 percent in quantity and 83.6 percent in value from 1976. Chum landings experienced a decline from 24.1 million pounds in 1976 valued at 14.8 million to 13.3 million pounds in 1977 valued at \$7.9 million.

Halibut landings in the North Pacific by both United States and Canada declined to 21.9 million pounds in 1977 - down 20.3 percent from the 27.5 million pounds landed the previous year. Landings by Canadian fishermen of 8.7 million pounds were only lower in 1974 when 7.5 million pounds were caught. The value of the 1977 catch was \$11.2 million - down by 33.9 percent from 1976. Over 28.7 percent of the Canadian catch was landed at United States ports, accounting for 26.1 percent of the value to fishermen.

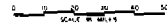
The herring fishery attained a record value this year at \$33.6 million (including herring spawn on kelp). This fishery was directed mainly for the Japanese herring roe market, but in January 1977 some food herring was exported to Japan for the dried market and in the latter part of the year Europeans purchased significant quantities for processing into food. The value of the herring catch in 1977 was up by 38 percent from the 1976 level of \$23.4 million.



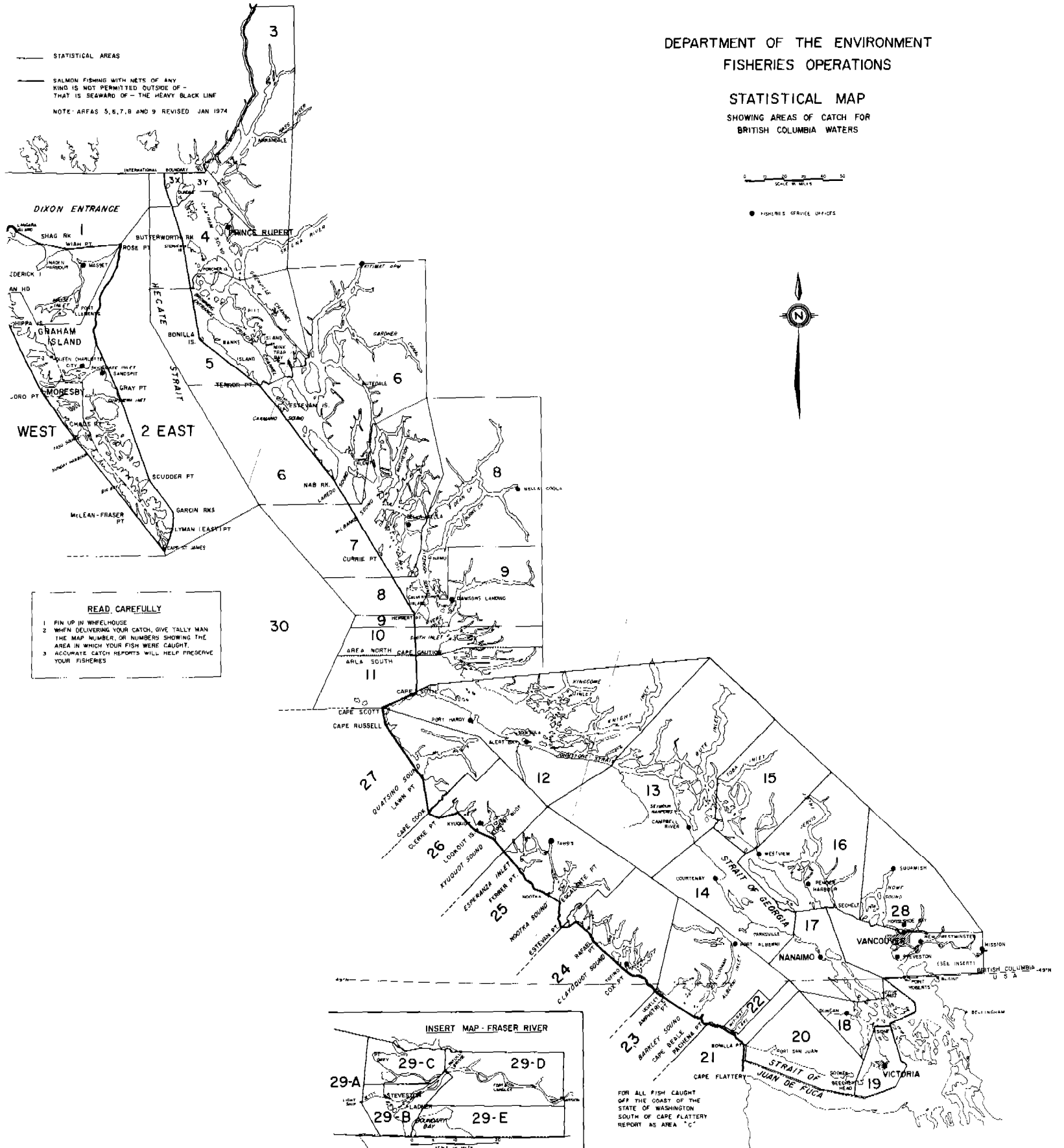

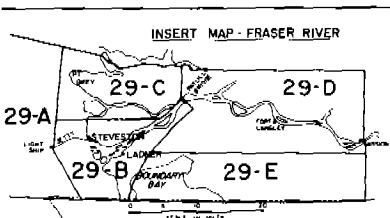

HALIBUT

Halibut landings of 8.7 million pounds valued at \$11.2 million were down by 27 percent in quantity and 25 percent in value from the previous year. The quantity landed at United States ports was nearly the same as the previous year at 2.5 million pounds valued at \$2.9 million.

HERRING

Herring landings reached their highest level since 1966 at 107.1 thousand tons valued at \$32.5 million. In 1977, seventy-six percent of the landings were for the roe market in Japan while the European market absorbed most of the balance for processing into food.

OTHER FISH

In the other fish category, groundfish species constitute the largest part. Sole, grey cod and ling cod are down from the previous year while landings of rockfish, turbot and dogfish show significant increases from 1976.

SHELLFISH

Shellfish landings of 19.2 million pounds are down slightly from their 1976 level. Small declines were recorded by shrimp and oysters while crabs, clams and abalone show an increase from the previous year. In value terms abalone and shrimp landings were most important at \$1.7 million each while crab landings followed with a landed value of \$1.2 million.

SALMON

Salmon landings in 1977 of 144.6 million pounds (round weight) were up by 14 percent from 1976, while the landed value of \$108.7 million was up by 18 percent from the previous year. Sockeye and pinks landings recorded significant increases in terms of both quantity and value, while chum landings were down considerably from the previous year. The weighted average price per pound (round weight) of sockeye and pink salmon rose by 11 percent and 27 percent respectively; spring and coho prices rose only slightly and chum prices declined from 1976.

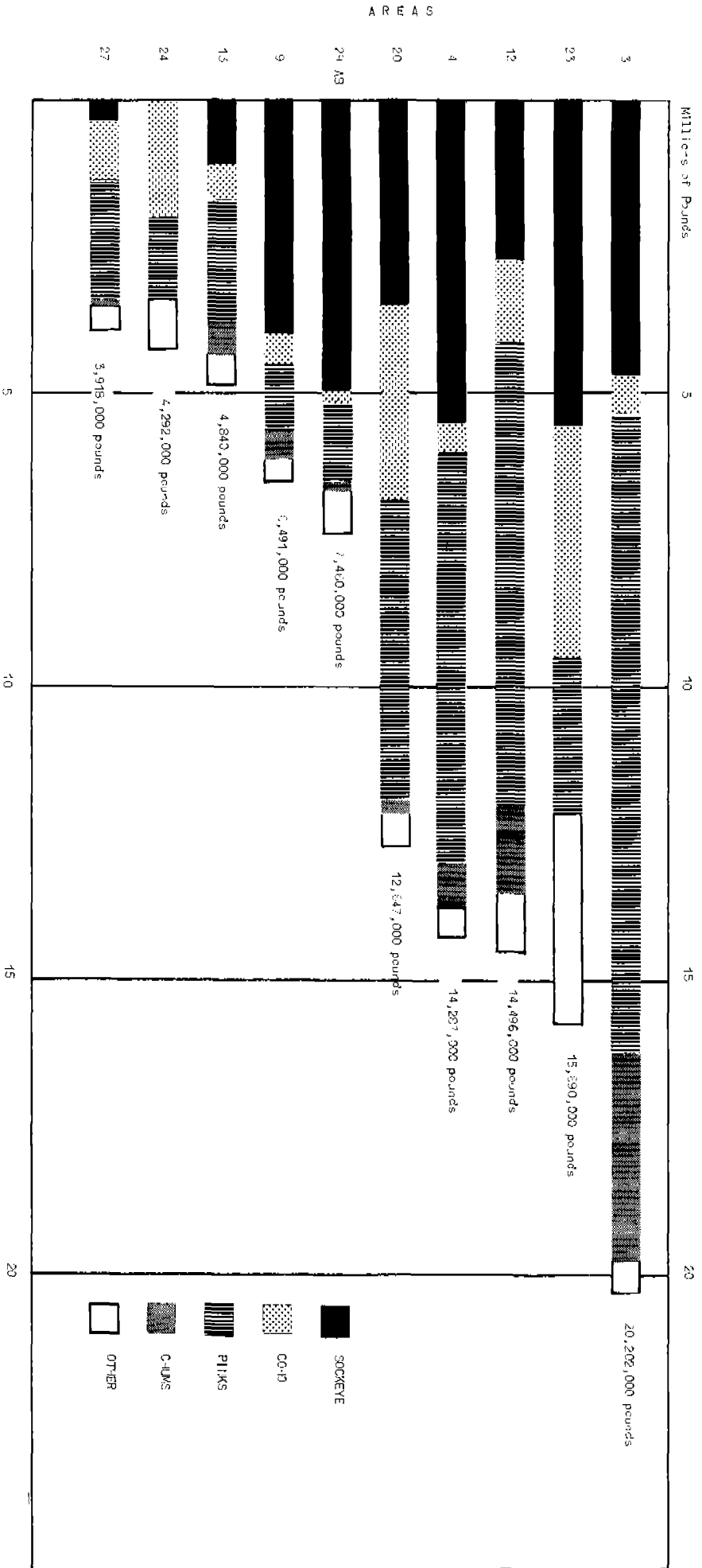

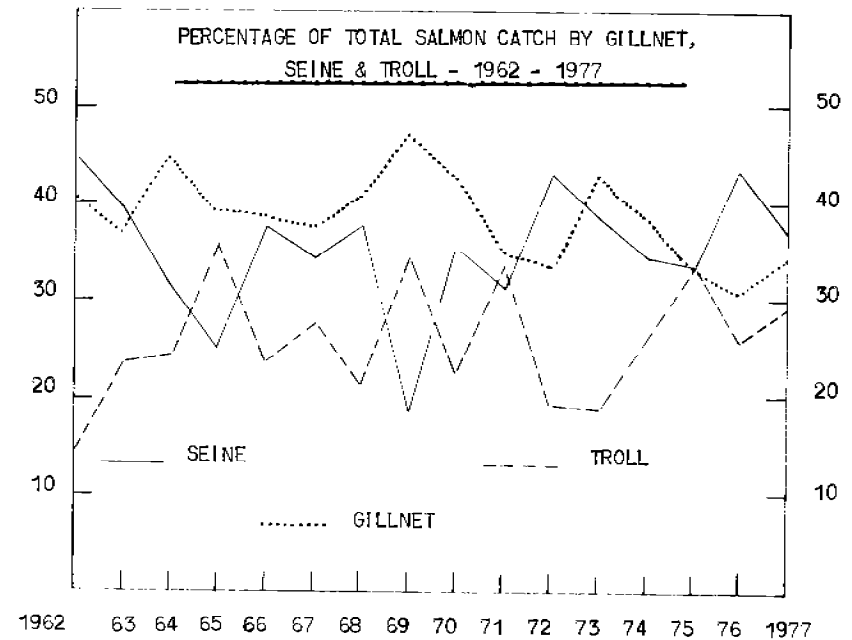
